Petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to take legal action on the basis of representation dated 06.03.2013 (Annexure P-4).

It appears, petitioner is an accused in an FIR No.149 dated 06.04.2013, registered against him under sections 420, 406, 120-B IPC at Police Station Faridabad Central District, Faridabad. It is inexplicable how petitioner can pray for a direction to the department to take action against respondent No.4. His locus standi to seek such a relief is not clear. Nor any Constitutional or legal right of the petitioner has been infringed. The petition is wholly misconceived. Same is hereby dismissed.
