Varun Sharma Vs Bhupinder Singh and another

Present: Mr. Varun Sharma, appellant present in person.

As agreed, as per statements of the representative of the Insurance Company and the appellant, (separately recorded today), a sum of ₹ 2,50,000/- (₹ Two Lacs Fifty Thousand Only) more, over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded as enhanced compensation to the appellant, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of appellant-Varun Sharma, he is agreed to accept the aforesaid enhanced amount of compensation.

We dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to transfer the enhanced amount of compensation i.e. ₹ 2,50,000/- by way of NEFT in the account of appellant-Varun Sharma, in case the claimant furnishes details of his bank account within a period of two weeks from today to the insurance company. However, in case no such particulars are furnished during the aforesaid time period, the same be deposited in Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Patiala (MACT) on or before 22.12.2017 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the deposit of the aforesaid amount and the appellant may collect the same from MACT, Patiala.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
