It is contended that the petitioners are entitled to the benefit of services rendered on ad hoc/current duty charge and counting of that period for promotion. The petitioners have already represented the respondents-Department vide legal notice dated 22.12.2016 (Annexure P-4), however, the same is still pending consideration. Learned counsel for the petitioners limits his prayer that the said legal notice dated 22.12.2016 (Annexure P-4) should be decided expeditiously.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and in view of the limited prayer, without going into the merits of the case, I dispose of the instant writ petition by directing the respondents-Department to decide the legal notice dated 22.12.2016 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioners within a

period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

Needless to say, in case there is merit in the claim of the petitioners, the necessary relief be granted to them within a period of one month thereafter.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
