Petitioner has prayed for a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct respondents No.1 & 2 to issue a passport to him. According to him, an FIR was registered against the petitioner under section 420 IPC. Police filed cancellation report therein, which has been accepted.

At this stage, Learned counsel for Union of India submits that in case a fresh application is moved by the petitioner, same shall be considered by the passport authority, at the earliest, as per law.
