As agreed, as per statements of the representative of the Insurance Company and counsel for the appellants, (separately recorded today), a sum of ₹ 2,85,000/- (Rs.Two Lakh Eighty Five Thousand Only) more, over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, out of the enhanced compensation of ₹ 2,85,000/-, ₹ 2,00,000/- be paid to appellant No.1-Neeru Sharma and balance ₹ 85,000/- be paid to appellant No.3-Satya Devi.

We dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit two crossed-cheques; 1) in the sum of ₹ 2,00,000/- in the name of appellant No.1-Neeru Sharma wd/o Sh. Gurdayal Sharma, and 2) in the sum of ₹ 85,000/- in the name of appellant No.3-Satya Devi wd/o Sh. Kharaiti Lal Sharma with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 07.02.2017 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheques are deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellants' counsel/appellant may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied/sent to the
counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
