The appeal is filed against the order passed by the trial Court in an application praying for interim custody of the minor children, namely, Harteek and Harsh during the pendency of the main petition filed by the respondents herein under Section 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act, 1890.

When the matter came up for hearing before this Court on 30.01.2017, counsel for the appellants sought time to peruse the judgment passed by the trial Court in the main petition under Section 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act, 1890.

None has appeared for the appellants.

The judgment passed on 17.01.2017 by the trial Court under

Section 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act, 1890 was produced by the learned counsel appearing for the respondents for our perusal. On a perusal of the judgment it is found that the appellants herein were directed to hand over the custody of the minor children, namely, Harteek and Harsh to the respondents herein.

In as much as the main petition under Section 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act, 1890 has been disposed of by the trial Court on 17.01.2017, the challenge, which has been made by the appellants in FAO No. 6215 of 2013 against the interim custody granted by the trial Court during the pendency of the above main petition, has become infructuous.

The appeal stands dismissed accordingly.
