The petitioner has preferred this writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to release the benefit of ACP on completion of four years' of service as per notification dated 03.11.2016 which has been illegally withheld by the respondent department with all consequential benefits alongwith interest.

It comes out that the petitioners has filed the representations dated 18.08.2014 and 06.10.2016 (*Annexures P-2 and P-3*) before the respondents. Now, the short prayer of the petitioner is that the respondent No. 3 may be directed to decide the representations dated 18.08.2014 and 06.10.2016 (*Annexures P-2 and P-3*) within a specific time frame.

In the circumstances, without issuing notice to the respondents, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3, to decide the representations dated 18.08.2014 and 06.10.2016 (*Annexures P-2 and P-3*) of the petitioner by passing a speaking order within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
