In similar matters, the Competent Authority has passed the orders, which were challenged. Those petitions were disposed of by relegating the petitioner to file an appeal under Clause 17 of the Chandigarh Small Flats Scheme, 2006 (for short 'the Scheme). However, in the present petition, the Competent Authority has not passed the order yet.

The present petition is disposed of by directing the Competent Authority to pass an order on the application of the petitioner for allotment of a flat under the said Scheme. In the event of the petitioner being aggrieved by the order, he shall have the remedy for filing the appeal under Clause 17 of the Scheme.
