The petitioners claim themselves to be tenants in some structures said to have been constructed by owners of the land. Those owners have been served with the notices under Section 12(2) of the Punjab New Capital (Periphery) Control Act, 1952 for removal of the alleged unauthorized constructions. There is neither any proof that the petitioners are in occupation of the houses as tenants nor they admittedly are the owners of the land/houses. Similarly, it is not their case that the constructions were made legitimately in accordance with law.

As the petitioners have raised several disputed questions, we decline to entertain this writ petition relegating them to avail alternative remedy.

Ordered accordingly.
