The prayer made in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the inaction of the respondents-Bank declining the proposal for One Time Settlement made by the petitioner. Further prayer has been made to direct respondent No.1 to allow the petitioner to repay the loan amount as per settlement with the respondent-bank.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
