Vide arbitral award dated 22.02.2007, claim of the respondents was accepted. Being aggrieved against the said award, the appellant filed objections under Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. Concededly, the award dated 22.02.2007, was subsequently rectified vide an award, dated 23.05.2007, and vide letter Ex.R4, copy of the rectified award was sent to the parties. On being asked, learned counsel for the appellant fairly submits that no objection were preferred against the rectified/modified award, dated 23.05.2007. That being so, the only and the inevitable conclusion, the learned Additional District Judge could reach was to dismissed the objections preferred by the appellant being not maintainable. Nothing could be shown as to how the conclusion arrived at by the learned Court below was either contrary to the record or suffered from any material illegality.

In conspectus of the position as set out above, no ground is made out to interfere. The appeal being wholly devoid of merit is, accordingly, dismissed.
