The instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of Certiorari for quashing the order dated 03.07.2016 (Annexure P-3) by which respondent No. 3 herein was promoted despite being junior to the petitioner.

It is contended that the petitioner herein is entitled to promotion to the post of Lecturer as persons, junior to him, have been given the said promotion. In this regard, the petitioner has already submitted a representation to the respondents on 25.11.2016 for consideration of his case but the same is yet to be decided. At the present moment, limited prayer is made that the respondents should be directed to decide the said representation as expeditiously as possible.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and in view of the limited prayer made, without going into the merits of the case, the petitioner is given liberty to file a comprehensive representation afresh before the respondents within a period of two weeks and the respondents are

hereby directed to decide the same by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order thereafter. In case, the petitioner is found entitled to the relief as sought by way of this writ petition, the same be granted to him within a period of one month thereafter.
