Petitioner has filed a suit for mesne profits against the respondents.

Through the instant petition, the petitioner has merely sought expeditious disposal of the suit claiming that he is 83 years old and being a senior citizen, he has got a right of expeditious disposal of his case.

The petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner moves an application for expeditious disposal before the trial Court mentioning his age, the trial Court shall make earnest endeavour to expeditiously conclude the proceedings in the suit by giving short dates of hearing and provide a fair opportunity to the parties to produce their evidence. The trial Court shall make earnest endeavour to conclude the suit within a period of six months. It would be ensured that right of any of the parties of fair opportunity to produce evidence and being heard, is not prejudiced.
