The Standing Screening Committee had made its recommendations for allotment of an Industrial Plot to the petitioner and others in Electro-plating Zone, Sector-58, Faridabad. It appears that there were some deficiencies noticed in those recommendations, hence, the Chief Administrator, HUDA has referred the matter to be again placed before the Standing Screening Committee.

The petitioner claims that since his name was recommended for allotment of a plot, a writ of mandamus be issued to direct such allotment.

We are afraid that no enforceable right has accrued so far in favour of the petitioner for allotment of plot merely on the basis of recommendation made by the Standing Screening Committee. There is no final decision taken by the Competent Authority for acceptance of those recommendations. However, with a view to expedite the matter, it is directed that the Standing Screening Committee shall take an appropriate decision, if already not taken, within a period of three months from the date

take its final decision on those recommendations within two months thereafter.

The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
