Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that legal notice dated 19.02.2017 (Annexure P-4) served upon the respondents is pending consideration for benefits to be granted to the petitioners in terms of *LPA No. 589 of 2015* titled *State of Punjab and others vs. Kewal Singh, and other connected matters*. At the present moment, a limited prayer is made by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners that their notice dated 19.02.2017 (Annexure P-4) be decided as expeditiously as possible.

In view of the limited prayer made, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to file a fresh representation to the respondents within a period of two weeks along with the certified copy of this order, who in turn, on receipt of the said representation, are directed to decide the same by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of four months thereafter. In case, they are found entitled to the relief claimed, then the same be granted to them within a period of two months thereafter.
