M.JEYAPPAUL, J.(ORAL)

Both the parties were present alongwith their respective counsel. They individually suffered their statements in second motion. A sum of ₹ 4,75,000/- in the shape of two bank drafts being the remaining amount to be paid by petitioner No.1 to petitioner No.2 towards permanent alimony and other claims was handed over by petitioner No.1 to petitioner No.2. They have reiterated their original stand in first motion.

It is brought to our notice that all the criminal cases against petitioner No.1 have been withdrawn. It is submitted that the appeal against acquittal of petitioner No.1 preferred by the State is still pending disposal. In view of the fact that both the parties have amicably settled their dispute and have decided to live separately, the State may take a

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decision to withdraw the appeal preferred against acquittal of petitioner No.1 recorded in the criminal case. We are of the considered view that the facts stated in the joint petition filed by the parties are true. There is no scope of their living together as husband and wife. Accordingly decree of divorce by mutual consent is granted and the marriage between the parties is dissolved. Decree sheet be prepared accordingly.

Appeal stands disposed of.
