Petitioners, through instant petition, seek issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.3 to provide the scheduled time tables/booth timings from the counter within Bus Stand to operate their city buses as per the route permits on the allotted routes.

In this context, petitioners appear to have submitted a legal notice to the Secretary-cum-Member, RTA, Gurgaon, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-4.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners will be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to the Secretary-cum-Member, RTA, Gurgaon to consider legal notice Annexure P-4 by passing a speaking order taking into consideration the circumstances mentioned in the notice.

This petition is disposed of, at this stage, with a direction to the Secretary-cum-Member, RTA, Gurgaon to consider legal notice of the petitioners Annexure P-4 dated 19.01.2017 within a period of two months by passing a speaking order after the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, the petitioners are required to explain the circumstances by availing personal hearing, the same may also be granted to the petitioners.

It will be the responsibility of the petitioners to communicate the order to the above said authority.
