This petition is filed for seeking direction to the respondents to make necessary corrections in spelling of surname of the petitioner as well as in the surname of his parents in Matriculation certificate in which it has been wrongly mentioned as “Braich” instead of “Waraich”.

After notice, the respondents have not filed any reply but at the same time, learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that it is only the correction of the spelling of surname because there is no surname as “Braich” rather actually the surname is “Waraich”. It is also submitted that in any case Clause 69-1(ii) of the Examination Bye-Laws of CBSE provides for such type of corrections. It is further submitted that for Class XII, the correction has already been done.

Thus, keeping in view the facts and circumstances, the present petition is hereby allowed and direction is issued to the respondents to make necessary corrections in the spelling of surname of the petitioner as well as in the surname of his parents in matriculation certificate by correcting the word “Braich” as “Waraich”.

It is further directed that fresh DMC shall be issued to the petitioner with the aforesaid correction within a period of one month.
