Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of writ of mandamus directing the respondents to fix the monthly pay of the petitioners notionally along with consequential service benefit.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that the petitioners had made representation dated 26.9.2016 (Annexure P-8) and thereafter, got issued legal notice dated 29.1.2016 (Annexure P-12), which remained undecided by the respondents, whereby the petitioners had claimed benefit of notional pay, which was granted to other employees, as per policy of the Government.

Without making any observation on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with direction to respondent No. 2 to consider and decide representation dated 26.9.2016 (Annexure P-8) and legal notice dated 29.1.2016 (Annexure P-12), in accordance with law, within a

period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
