TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J. (Oral)

Petitioner had applied for the post of Constable (Male) under the Sports Category (Football Discipline) in response to an advertisement dated 23.11.2016 issued by the Punjab Police Department. He is aggrieved of his non-selection as his name does not figure in the final select list that has been put in public domain.

The sole contention raised by the learned counsel is that the respondent-authorities/Selection Agency has not acted upon the selection criteria, disclosed in the advertisement inasmuch as the petitioner has been denied two marks on account of his participation at a Junior National Event in the year 2016.

There is no document/material placed on record, which would prima facie substantiate the assertion made by counsel during the course of hearing.

Under such circumstances, the prayer in the petition for setting aside the merit list of Male Constables and to re-notify the result by grant of two marks to the petitioner, cannot be adjudicated upon.

Confronted with such a situation, counsel prays for withdrawal of the petition with liberty to approach this Court afresh with better particulars in the light of the observations made by this Court in this order.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
