Short affidavit of Sh. Sanjeev Kumar Gupta, Divisional Engineer (C-1) has been filed on behalf of the Greater Mohali Area Development Authority (respondent No.2). The affidavit is taken on record.

The petitioner by way of the present petition seeks directions against the respondents to restore the green park situated at Sector 56, SAS Nagar, near Shivalik Public School, SAS Nagar, Mohali. A further prayer has been made for removing the illegal structures that were being raised by the Greater Mohali Area Development Authority and the Municipal Corporation, Mohali (respondents No.2 and 3) in violation of the earlier orders of this Court in Civil Writ Petition No.15142 of 2012 decided on

08.08.2012.

In terms of the affidavit, that has been filed, it is stated that on request of various residential welfare associations situated in SAS Nagar for construction of Public Library in various public parks, the Additional Chief Administrator, Greater Mohali Area Development Authority (respondent No.2) accorded approval for the construction of a Public Library in Sector 56, SAS Nagar, Mohali. Construction for the same was commenced by constructing a temporary washroom/bathroom and a temporary water tank for use during the construction. At present the construction of Public Library, it is stated is complete and all the temporary structures including the temporary washroom/bathroom and temporary water tank has been removed. It is further stated that since the construction is now complete, the park would be restored to its original green level within next 15 days.

Keeping in view the assurance given by the Greater Mohali Area Development Authority (respondent No.2) for restitution of the park in question within 15 days, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is held to be infructuous.

Accordingly we dispose of this petition as infructuous.
