SURYA KANT, J. (Oral)

(1) The instant writ petition is directed against the order dated 22.03.2017 vide which the Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench, Chandigarh (in short, 'the Tribunal') has issued bailable warrants to secure the presence of respondent No.2 who has failed to comply with the Tribunal's order dated 10.02.2016 despite sufficient opportunities.

(2) We would also have declined to interfere with the order but for the reason that learned counsel for the petitioners, on instructions, states that an affidavit shall be filed before the Tribunal on 05.04.2017 with an undertaking to comply with the Tribunal's order within *three weeks*.

(3) If such an affidavit is filed on 05.04.2017 and the petitioner-authorities undertake that the order dated 10.02.2016 shall be complied with within *three weeks*, we request the Tribunal to recall the bailable warrants so as to give last opportunity to the Engineering-in-Chief – petitioner No.2 to comply with the Tribunal's order.

(4) Disposed of. **Dasti.**
