The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of *Mandamus*, for direction to respondent No.1 not to pass order reserved on 17.03.2017 in appeal bearing No.02 of 2016, before hearing all the pleadings of the petitioner's advocate and directions be also issued to respondent No.1 not to pass any other order in the aforesaid appeal during the pendency of the present writ petition.
