After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court is of the opinion that the petitioner, on behalf of a proclaimed offender, Surjit Singh who is residing abroad, has sought a direction to the CBI to consider the request of the petitioner for dropping the proceedings against said Surjit Singh.

Main accused Surjit Singh may have a good case on merits for seeking the withdrawal or cancellation of the criminal proceedings launched against him but the petitioner is neither a power of attorney holder nor has got any locus standi to seek a direction to the CBI for consideration of the violation of the rights of Surjit Singh.

Petition apparently is not maintainable.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at this stage, seeks permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to file fresh petition in accordance with law for challenging the infringement of any right of life and liberty of the person concerned i.e. Surjit Singh.

Disposed of as withdrawn without prejudice to the right of the petitioner.
