The petitioners' case is that their land fully described in para No.2 of the writ petition was acquired vide Award No.2 dated 12.12.1990 for setting-up new Grain Market at Safidon, District Jind. It is urged that as per the policy-decision taken by the State Government in the year 1987 and as revised by way of Rehabilitation and Resettlement Policy dated 09.11.2010, oustees of the Haryana State Agricultural Marketing Board (for short, 'the Board') are entitled to allotment of plots in the new Grain Market for which their lands are acquired. On this premise, the petitioners after more than two decades have submitted a representation dated 21.06.2016 (P-6) followed by the instant writ petition.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and considering the nature of relief sought in the writ petition but without expressing any views on merits or on the question of delay, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.2 to 4 to verify the petitioners' claim regarding entitlement for allotment of plots under the oustees policy and take an appropriate decision in accordance with law within a period of four months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
