There are multiple rounds of litigation at the behest of the petitioners. Earlier the petitioners filed CWP No.2973 of 2013 seeking direction for approval of of remoduled design of the booth sheds allotted to them in lieu of *rehri* licences. The writ petition was disposed of with time bound directions to the authorities. Thereafter, they filed CWP No.14589 of 2015 in which they questioned the allotment of sheds “instead of built-up booths”. The said writ petition was dismissed by this Court on 22.12.2015. This time the petitioners seek a direction to the Chandigarh Administration to reduce the 'interest component' levied on the allotment price of the booths'/sheds allotted to them in Sector-42, Chandigarh under the Rehabilitation Policy.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and considering the nature of relief sought in this writ petition but without expressing any views on the merits of their claim, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the above-stated claim which has also been raised by the petitioners vide a legal notice dated

decided by way of a speaking order within a period of four months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
