Both the parties along with their respective counsel are present.
They have also entered into a compromise on 11.01.2017 before the
Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and the same has been
placed on record.

In terms of the compromise, a sum of Rs.12 lacs out of 13.5
lacs has been agreed to be paid by the appellant to the respondent towards
permanent alimony while other claims already stand paid by him to the
respondent. Appellant agrees to pay the remaining amount of Rs.1.50 lacs
during the first motion before the trial Court.

Both the parties have agreed to file a joint petition under
Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act before the trial Court in terms of
the compromise arrived at before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of
this Court. Let them do so.

In the background of the above development, learned counsel appearing for the appellant seeks permission to withdraw the appeal with liberty to file a joint petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act before the trial Court.

Permission is granted.

Appeal stands dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as sought for.
