The petitioner-Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Limited was allotted a site measuring 1350 square yard in Sector 51-A, Chandigarh on 09.10.2000, for installation of petrol filling-cum-service station. The allotment was eventually cancelled on 01.07.2003 as the petitioner failed to deposit the due amount of rent. The petitioner filed appeal which was dismissed by the Chief Administrator, U.T., Chandigarh vide order dated 02.12.2008 (P-3). The said order has attained finality.

We are satisfied that such a quasi-judicial order cannot be set-aside by the respondent-authorities in exercise of their administrative powers.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let Chandigarh Administration consider the petitioner's request for a fresh allotment of the subject site.

In view of the nature of alternative prayer, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction that let the petitioner-Corporation apply for allotment of the subject site on current allotment price and such a request

may be considered by the Chandigarh Administration in accordance with its

policy, as early as possible and preferably within a period of three months from the date of submission of the application by the petitioner.

Ordered accordingly.
