The petitioner has approached this Court for issuance a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.3 and 4 to decide the complaint dated 05.02.2016 against the respondent No.6 for misusing the fund of the Gram Panchayat and selling the tree of the village Panchayat without passing the resolution.

It is a clear cut case of animosity being grudged, much less, wrecking of vengeance against the private respondent(s) as the petitioner has, according to the counsel for the petitioner, made a complaint for illegal cutting of the trees, to the respondent No.2/Director, Rural Development and Panchayat Department, Punjab, for taking an action against the private respondent(s). Such type of cases cannot be entertained in a writ jurisdiction, much less, cannot be brought within the realm of judicial review.

Keeping in view the aforementioned facts, no ground is made out for interference and accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed.
