Affidavit of Chief Administrator, HUDA, Panchkula dated
6.12.2017 filed in court is taken on record.

Whatever efforts the court could make to impress upon the
authorities to arrange funds for payment of compensation to the landowners,
have been done. The liability runs into thousands of crores, which is still to
be discharged. Even as per the order passed by Hon'ble the Supreme Court
on 6.9.2017, compensation as determined is to be deposited within four
months thereof. Approach of the officers does not seem to be proactive to
take care of the emergent situation. They are working at their own ease.

In the present petition, the petitioner has not been paid the
compensation determined on an application filed by the petitioner under
Section 28-A of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894.

As the claim of the respondents is that enough money is available but they are not able to disburse, the petitioner be paid the amount of compensation within one week.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
