The result of the petitioner has been produced by the State Counsel in sealed cover. Same is opened and a photocopy of the same is taken on record as 'Mark-A'. A perusal of the same shows that the petitioner, who belongs to SC category, has got 51.40 marks. He had been unable to appear in the Physical Measurement Test, for the post of Constable (Male) General Duty, on account of the fact that he had been suffering from chikungunia.

As per the result declared on 23.06.2017 (Annexure P-10), the result of the petitioner had been kept in sealed cover, on account of the pendency of the present case. A perusal of the result would go on to show that for SC category, the last candidate had secured 54.60 marks and therefore, the petitioner does not come within the zone of consideration.

Resultantly, in view of the above, the present writ petition has, thus, been rendered infructuous, on account of the petitioner having not made the grade and the same is, disposed of, accordingly.
