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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The petitioner retired from service as a Senior Auditor with effect from 31.7.2016 on attaining the age of superannuation. The prayer made in the present writ petition is for release of the retiral benefits and for regularizing the suspension period from 9.11.2015 to 18.4.2016. The learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has moved representations dated 8.9.2016, 21.12.2016 and 17.3.2017 (Annexures-P-9 to P-11 respectively) to respondents, but to no avail. The short prayer at this stage is for directing respondents to decide the aforesaid representations of the petitioner, in a time bound manner by passing a speaking order.

In these circumstances, as requested by the learned counsel for the petitioner, without issuing notice to the opposite party, the present writ petition is disposed of with directions to respondents to consider the aforesaid representations of the petitioner dated 8.9.2016, 21.12.2016 and 17.3.2017 (Annexures-P-9 to P-11 respectively) and decide the same within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order by passing a speaking order.
