Petitioner claims that it is a Transport Contractor for procurement agency FCI, pursuant to a tender having been accepted for a period till 02.08.2017 vide allotment letter dated 30.06.2015, Annexure P-2. On account of threats to the life and liberty of the members of petitioner-Society, the petitioner had submitted a representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, Annexure P-4.

Through instant petition, the petitioner seeks protection of the life and liberty of its members in order to enable the petitioner-Society to carry out the execution of the transport contract peacefully without any hinderance.

Notice to Advocate General, Punjab.

On asking of the Court, Mr. P.S. Bajwa, Addl. A.G, Punjab, present in the Court, accepts notice.

Counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over two sets of the paper book to the State counsel, during course of the day.

Without expression of any opinion on merits of the case, this petition is disposed of, at this stage, with a direction to the Senior

Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, to look into representation Annexure P-4 to ensure the prevention of breach of peace and to check any threat to the life and liberty of the members of the petitioner-Society, by looking into the grievance of the petitioner within a period of one month.

In case of any imminent threat to the members of the petitioner-Society, it will be open to the them to approach the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran for personal hearing.

It is expected that in said eventuality considering the situation, necessary steps will be taken to prevent breach of peace or harm to the life and liberty of any one.
