The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners at this stage merely seeks an order directing the respondents to respond to their legal notice dated 24.03.2017 (Annexure P-5). The petitioners contend that despite their tender being the most competitive the work was not allotted to them and was instead allotted to another party. The tenders were invited in April, 2016. The learned counsel states that the tender was only for a period of one year.

2. No relief, therefore, can be granted in respect of the tender.

3. The petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to respond to the petitioners' legal notice dated 24.03.2017 (Annexure P-5) to enable the petitioners to take any further action, if they so desire.
