He has sent representations in this regard to respondents No. 2, 3 and 4, which have failed to evoke any response so far. Learned counsel further contends that he shall be satisfied if this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 4 to consider and decide his representation dated 05.04.2017 (Annexure P-3 colly.).

Issue notice to respondents No. 1 to 4.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Vaibhav Sharma, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction to respondent No. 4-Inspector General, Border Range, Amritsar to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law within a period of one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
