Counsel would advert to memo dated 5.4.2017 at Annexure P-2, issued by the District Controller, Food Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Sangrur and in favour of the petitioner to contend that a contract with regard to supply of labour in respect of certain Godowns had been awarded and in pursuance to which even the security amount had been deposited.

Grievance raised in the instant petition is that certain members of a rival Paledar Union i.e. respondent no.14 are threatening to kill the petitioner so as to prevent him from undertaking the contractual assignment.

Prayer is for providing police protection so as to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as also to ensure that the work is undertaken in pursuance to memo dated 5.4.2017 (Annexure P-2).

Without ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the same with a direction to respondent no.3 i.e. the Deputy Commissioner, Sangrur to look into the matter in the light of a representation dated 5.4.2017 (Annexure P-4) that is stated to have already been submitted and to thereafter take necessary steps as deemed fit and warranted strictly in accordance with law.

Petition disposed of.
