Through instant writ petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing respondents No. 2 and 3 to ensure that the petitioner is able to carry out the execution of the labour and cartage contract allotted vide Annexures P-1 and P-2 dated 05.04.2017 without any hindrance of the private respondents who allegedly create nuisance and hardships. In this context, the petitioner has already submitted a representation regarding obstruction in execution of the tender work and expressing his right to life and liberty vide Annexure P-7 dated 10.04.2017 addressed to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga.

Notice to the Advocate General, Punjab.

On asking of the Court, notice has been accepted by Ms. Anu Pal, Asstt.A.G., Punjab present in the Court. Copy given.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga to consider the grievance of the petitioner and to ensure the maintenance of peace as well as law and order by considering the grievance of the petitioner regarding

obstruction in the execution of tender work. The grievance of the petitioner vide Annexure P-7 dated 10.04.2017 will be considered within a period of one month after receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case of any imminent threat, it will be open to the petitioner to approach the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga with the grievance, expecting that the grievance will be fairly looked into, in accordance with law.
