One of the grievance in the instant writ petition is that the petitioners have filed a revision petition before the State Government challenging the order dated 20.10.2016 whereby the respondent-Board has made re-allotment of sites in favour of private-respondents in new Grain Market at Tosham, by carving out such plots out of the parking area. Alongwith the revision petition, the petitioners have also filed an application seeking interim stay of the order dated 20.10.2016. Their stay application has not been taken up for hearing so far. Owing to the urgency involved, the petitioners seek a direction for early disposal of their stay application. It may be mentioned that one of the ground taken by the petitioners in their revision petition is that re-allotments have been made as a result of favouritism and one of the beneficiary is sister-in-law of an official of the Market Committee, Tosham.

In the light of the nature of allegations, we deem it appropriate to dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the Revisional Authority to decide the stay application within two weeks and thereafter, let the main

revision petition be decided preferably within four months. Till the stay application is decided, *status-quo* re: construction of re-allotted sites shall be maintained.

Ordered accordingly.
