KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The petitioner was working as Warder in the Mental Hospital, Amritsar. During his service, he was booked in case FIR No.122, dated 17.07.1989, under Sections 302, 307, 324, 506, 148 read with Section 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.8, Amritsar. He was placed under suspension w.e.f. 19.07.1989.

Suffice to say that he was convicted by the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Amritsar and sentenced to undergo imprisonment of life along with fine vide order dated 06.08.1996 (Annexure P-1). His sentence was upheld in appeal by this Court, vide order dated 09.11.2000 (Annexure P-2). However, the Governor of Punjab remitted some portion of his sentence, vide order dated 19.08.2013 (Annexure P-5). During his suspension period, he superannuated on 31.10.1996.

It is claimed that despite his repeated visits, the retiral benefits were not released. No adverse order has been passed against him and his pensionary benefits are being withheld illegally. The petitioner has already

moved representation dated 11.06.2016 (Annexure P-11).

The short prayer of the learned counsel for the petitioner at this stage is that the respondent Nos.2 and 3 may be directed to decide his representation dated 11.06.2016 (Annexure P-11) within a time bound manner.

In these circumstances, without issuing notice to the respondents, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner dated 11.06.2016 (Annexure P-11) within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
