The petitioner is a Commission Agent (Kacha Arhtia) in Grain Market at Safidon under licence dated 16.11.1992. The New Grain Market has also been set-up at Safidon in which the petitioner was not allotted a plot on preferential/concessional basis. The petitioner challenged the action of the Market Committee in appeal which was allowed by the Chief Administrator of the respondent-Board vide order dated 22.09.2014. In compliance thereto, the Market Committee, Safidon resolved on 27.11.2014 to allot plot No.234 to the petitioner. The grievance of the petitioner, however, is that neither the allotment letter has been issued nor possession of the plot has been handed-over so far. The petitioner has in this regard represented the Market Committee vide representations dated 30.12.2015 (P-4) and 30.08.2016 (P-5). But finding no response thereto, the instant writ petition has been filed.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that as per the petitioner, the order passed by the Appellate Authority has attained finality, the writ petition is disposed of with a

direction to the Market Committee, Safidon to take an appropriate decision with regard to the above-mentioned claim of the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.
