The grievance of the petitioners as projected in this writ petition is that they were allotted plots in the Additional Grain Market at Cheeka through open auction, being the highest bidders, in the year 2014. The allotments were however suspended and consequently possession of the sites was not given to them for a period of almost two years till 18.04.2016 when suspension of allotment of sites was revoked and allotments have been regularized. The petitioners have been consequently asked to deposit the additional outstanding dues.

On the other hand, the petitioners claim that due to denial of possession for over two years, they have suffered a huge loss and now they are not interested in allotment and want to get their amount refunded.

Since the decision-cum-communication dated 18.04.2016 sent by the Market Committee, Cheeka is appealable before the Board and/or other superior Authority, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he would file an appeal against the above-stated communication within one month. Let the appeal, if any filed, be decided on merits and in accordance

with law within a period of four months from the date of its filing.
