This is a writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to comply with order dated 08.02.2016 passed by the District Magistrate, Fazilka, Annexure P-2 regarding the sound of the loudspeakers used in the locality to be curtailed within the boundary wall of the religious places and marriage palaces.

Through instant writ petition, it is complained that order Annexure P-2 is not being immaculately followed by the religious institutions as well as in the marriage parties.

In this context, a representation seems to have been submitted by petitioner No.1 in the capacity as Sarpanch of Gram Panchayat village Khippan Wali, Tehsil and District Fazilka vide Annexure P-3 on the basis of resolution Annexure P-4.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners.

Violation of order of District Magistrate, Annexure P-2, has been complained of in the present writ petition but perusal of representation Annexure P-3 as well as the writ petition, does not indicate any specific

instance mentioning the place, time or date indicating the violation of prohibition order Annexure P-2. As such, it is debatable whether any cause has accrued for implementation of order in public interest.

This petition is disposed of on the ground of being vague and uncertain. However, it will be open to the petitioners to point out the specific instances to the S.D.M. Fazilka or the District Magistrate, Fazilka regarding violation of the order, Annexure P-2.

In case, any such information is provided to the administrative authorities and the violation is not looked into, it will be open to the petitioners to approach this Court again.
