Through instant writ petition, the petitioners seek issuance of direction to the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Sonapat to expeditiously dispose of the case No.236 of 2015 tilted “Deshmitter Talwar and another Vs. Rekha”, claiming that the same had been filed on 23.12.2015 and application under Order VII Rule 11 CPC, is still pending. Petitioners claim that they are senior citizens.

I have considered the facts and circumstances of the case and I am of the opinion that in case the petitioners move an application before the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Sonapat for expeditious disposal of the trial by mentioning that they are senior citizens, on the next date of hearing, the trial Court shall make earnest endeavour to ensure the adjudication of application under Order VII Rule 11 CPC and to take steps for expeditious disposal of the case by giving short dates of hearing.

This petition is disposed of with aforesaid liberty, at this stage.
