Through instant writ petition, the petitioner has challenged the order annexure P-5 dated April 16, 2017 issued by respondent No.4 directing the petitioner to execute the labour and cartage work at Storage Centre, Phula Mandi whereas he was bound to execute the work at Storage Centre, Nathana.

In the reply filed by District Controller-cum-District Manager, Food and Civil Supplies, Bathinda, it is stated that the Allotment Committee has again looked into the matter and cancelled the black listing order of the petitioner vide order dated April 28, 2017, copy of which has been placed on record as annexure R-1. As per the said order, the petitioner was allowed to

work at Nathana Purchase Centre as pleaded by him. It has also been ordered by the tender allotment committee that for paddy season, fresh tender for labour and cartage be invited for mandis/ storage points (except purchase centre Nathana) falling under Nathana Centre with the prior approval of the Deputy Director (Field), Bathinda Division.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous without prejudice to the rights of the petitioner.
