The instant writ petition has been filed seeking benefit of four additional marks that have been given to similarly situated candidates who had participated in Punjab State Teachers Eligibility Test (Paper-II) conducted in July, 2011.

It is contended that an Expert Committee was constituted and the Committee, in its report dated 12.10.2015, came to the conclusion that the answers to Question Nos. 12, 13, 26 and 81 of Booklet Set 'B' are wrong. It was further decided that four additional marks would be given to the candidates who participated in the said test.

Counsel for the respondents-State submits that the matter is under consideration and a decision would be taken regarding grant of four additional marks to the petitioner herein within a period of two weeks.

In view of the assurance given by the learned State counsel, the instant writ petition is disposed of. Let the matter pertaining to grant of four

additional marks to the petitioner herein, as claimed on the basis of the opinion of the Expert Committee, be considered and a decision taken, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of two weeks from today and the same be communicated to the petitioner immediately thereafter.
