The present petition has been filed by 23 petitioners praying for a direction to the respondents not to evict or relocate them except in due course of law. The reliance was placed upon the provisions of Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Act, 2014.

When the case was taken up for hearing on 20.04.2017, it was found that petitioners at Sr. Nos. 1, 4, 6 and 10 had got their photographs clicked at the same rehri whereas petitioners No. 8 and 18 also had the photographs at the same place. The case was adjourned for today as the counsel, who filed the petition, was not available on the last date of hearing.

Today, learned counsel for the petitioners sought permission to withdraw the writ petition admitting that there was error.

Dismissed as withdrawn, however, subject to imposition of cost of ₹ 1,000/-each on petitioners No. 1, 4, 6, 8, 10 and 18, to be deposited with the Registry of this Court. The cost be deposited within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
