The instant writ petition has been filed for issuance of a writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the benefit of increments of proficiency step up, commutation of pension as well as revision of pay scales to the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that despite having made several representations, the aforesaid benefits have not been granted to the petitioner. At the present moment, limited prayer is made that the respondents should be directed to decide the representation of the petitioner as expeditiously as possible.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and in view of the limited prayer made, without going into the merits of the case, the petitioner is given liberty to file a fresh representation before the respondents within a period of two weeks along with certified copy of this order. In case such representation is filed within two weeks, the respondents are hereby directed to decide the same by passing a speaking order within a period of three months thereafter.

Writ petition stands disposed of.
