The petitioners have preferred the instant writ petition for issuance of a direction to the respondents to refix their monthly wages (without monetary benefit), in the pay scale of category-C instead of category-D and to modify their nomenclature from W.P.A to W.P.O along with notional benefit.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in this connection, a legal notice, dated 2.1.2017 (Annexure P-12) was issued to the respondents but despite the lapse of more than four months, the same has not been decided, and that they would be satisfied at this stage if in the first instance a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the same by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. Resultantly, respondent No.3 is

directed to decide the legal of the petitioners by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
