The instant writ petition has been filed seeking to impugn the action of the respondent-Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd., whereby in principle, it has been decided to outsource the operation and maintenance of 66 KV Sub Stations under Bathinda and Khanna region.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that in this regard, a legal notice dated 12.09.2016 (Annexure P-6) has already been served upon the respondents which is still pending consideration. At the present moment, limited prayer is made that the respondents should be directed to decide the claim of the petitioners as set up in the said legal notice as expeditiously as possible.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and in view of the limited prayer made, without going into the merits of the case, the respondents are hereby directed to decide the claim of the petitioners as set up in the legal notice dated 12.09.2016 (Annexure P-6) by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
