Grievance of the petitioners in the present petition is relating to selection and appointment to the post of Constable GD Male against Sports Quota in the Border Security Force pursuant to the advertisement dated 4.9.2016. During pendency of this petition, Commandant 25th Battalion by its communication to the respondents-counsel informed that advertisement dated 4.9.2016 has not been proceeded to and further fresh advertisement has been issued to fill up 196 sports persons (135 male and 61 female candidates) in the BSF against sports quota for the vacancies 2016-2017. In view of these facts and circumstances, petition do not survive for consideration.

Accordingly, petition stands disposed of.
